

Senior Accident Reconstructionist

Job Responsibilities:

Travel to crash sites and vehicle storage facilities or locations to perform field inspections pertaining to vehicle collision investigations. Inspect, measure, and obtain crash data through photographs, videos, notes, the use of a 3D scanner, the use of a total station, Event Data Recorder technology, or any other means useful to the investigation.

In addition to field work, perform data collection & research, gather photographic evidence, review materials provided, conduct testing, and analyze the results.

Apply recognized principles and practices in accordance with industry codes and standards.

Produce comprehensive oral and written reports detailing findings and conclusions as requested by client.

Handle evidence in a manner that conforms to industry standards.

Testify in depositions and court proceedings as required by client.

Create and present professional presentations for clients and industry conferences that assist in developing client relationships and establishing forensic expertise.

Maintain professional and technical knowledge by attending educational conferences, seminars, reviewing professional publications and attending/participating in professional societies.

Participate in activities that generate new business such as the company referral program, blog writing, and various other activities as agreed upon with executive management.

- BS Mechanical Engineering or training in collision reconstruction through law enforcement or other entity
- Collision reconstruction experience or a combination of accident investigation & collision reconstruction through an entity such as law enforcement
- Professional Engineer Registration Required (license must be active) or Accredited and in good standing with ACTAR
- Strong communication skills (written and verbal)
- Capacity to build and maintain goodwill relationships with both internal and external customers
